Designed to improve pMDI technique



To be used as a training device under the supervision of a healthcare professional.

Intended Use	How to prepare the placebo inhaler	
	<p><b>1.</b></p> 	<p><b>2.</b></p> 
<p><b>In Clinic for use with a placebo inhaler</b> Flo-Tone is designed as a training device to help the patient inhale correctly using a pressurised metered dose inhaler (pMDI). When the whistle begins to sound the patient is inhaling at the correct speed.</p>	<p>Place the <b>Flo-Tone</b> firmly onto the end of the placebo inhaler's mouthpiece, see above.</p>	<p>Shake the placebo inhaler 4 or 5 times to ensure that any loose objects are removed and that the contents of the inhaler are evenly mixed.</p>
How to use the placebo inhaler + Flo-Tone		
<p><b>3.</b></p> 	<p><b>4.</b></p> 	<p><b>5.</b></p> 
<p>Hold the placebo inhaler upright with your thumb on the base, below the mouthpiece. Breathe out as far as is comfortable. Do not breathe in again yet.</p>	<p>Place the mouthpiece between your teeth. Close your lips around it. Do not bite the mouthpiece. Breathe in gently through your mouth.</p>	<p>Just after starting to breathe in, and when you hear the <b>Flo-tone</b> whistle sound, press down on the top of the canister to release a puff of placebo. Do this while still breathing in steadily and deeply, keeping the whistle going for as long as you can.</p>
